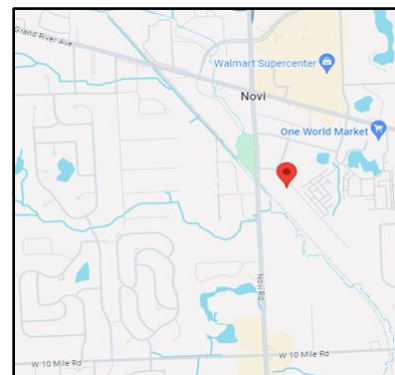

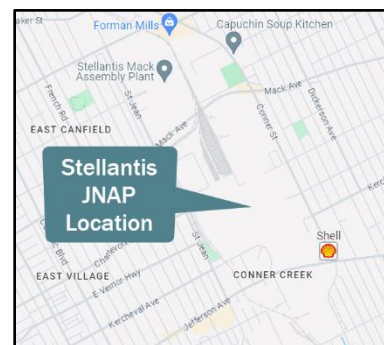


Figure 1: FCA US LLC Location

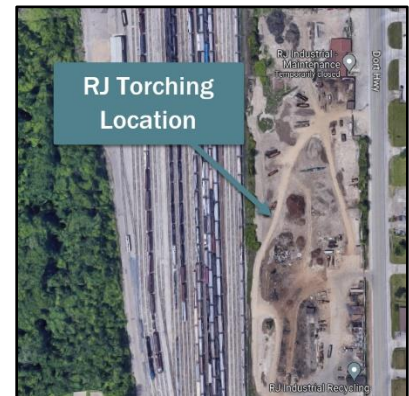


Figure 2: RJ Torching Location

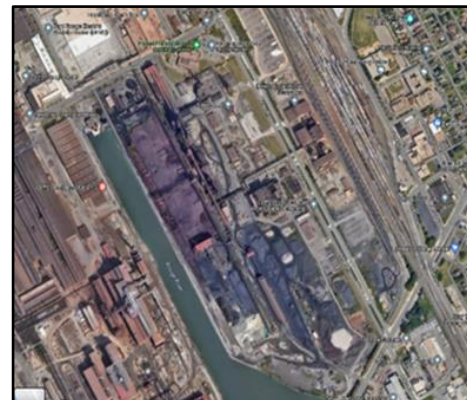


Figure 3: Cleveland Cliffs Location
