On your visit you noticed dust coming from the top of our cement silo. After investigating the seal for the cover was not sealing properly and when filling the silo dust would escape. After realizing this Stress-con immediately replaced the seals and doors on both silo's. This has been fix and stopped dust leaking from the top of the Silo.

We do dust control on our yard by using a water tanker that we pull with tractor soaking the ground with city water. We do this when dusty conditions are in the yard. We do this mostly during the dry season which is mostly summer but have used it in spring and fall. I did not know that I had to keep a log book on this but will start one and keep track.
