VIOLATION NOTICE

On August 13, 2013, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Quikrete-Flint located at 7072 E Grange Hall Road, Holly, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Quikrete-Flint's compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 530-96D.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

On August 13, 2013, the AQD staff observed operation of EU - Dryer while the device that measures the pressure loss of the gas stream through the wet scrubber was inoperable. This constitutes a violation of PTI No. 530-96D, Special Condition VI.2., which requires the permittee to maintain a device that measures the pressure loss of the gas stream through the wet scrubber.

During this inspection, Quikrete-Flint was unable to produce daily records of the pressure loss (in inches of water column) of the gas stream through the fabric filter dust collector for EU – Mixnbag. This is a violation of the recordkeeping specified in EU – Mixnbag, Special Condition number VI.3 of PTI number 530-96D, which requires the permittee to keep a daily record of the pressure loss (in inches of water column) of the gas stream through the fabric filter dust collector for EU – Mixnbag. The conditions of PTI number 530-96D require these records shall be kept on file for a period of at least five years and made available to the Air Quality Division upon request.

During this inspection, Quikrete-Flint was unable to produce daily records of visible emissions, in percent opacity, to show compliance for the opacity limits specified in Appendix B. This is a violation of the recordkeeping specified in EU – Process, Special Condition number VI.3 of PTI number 530-96D, which requires the permittee to keep a daily record of visible emissions, in percent opacity, to show compliance for the opacity limits specified in Appendix B. The conditions of PTI number 530-96D require these records shall be kept on file for a period of at least five years and made available to the Air Quality Division upon request.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by October 30, 2013. The written response should include:

- The dates the violations occurred:
- An explanation of the causes and duration of the violation;
- Whether the violations are ongoing;
- A summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and specify the dates by which these actions will take place; and
- Identify what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

Additionally, the daily records of the amount of material processed through EU – Process were not kept in a format acceptable to the AQD District Supervisor. The records provided on August 13, 2013, did not display a single daily value of the amount of material processed through EU – Process. Instead, additional calculation was required to determine the daily amount of material processed through EU – Process. Please format the records of the amount of material processed through EU – Process to show a single value that may be used to determine compliance with the process restriction specified in EU – Process, Special Condition III.1. Please provide the AQD a copies of the daily records of the amount of material processed through EU – Process, in a format acceptable to the AQD District Supervisor, by October 14, 2013.

If Quikrete-Flint believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
