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## Background

Howard Finishing SRN: B2363 is a surface treating facility located at 32565 Dequindre Rd, Madison Heights, MI 48071. The area around the manufacturing facility was inspected on Tuesday October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2016 by Tyler Salamasick of the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division. The intent of the inspection was to investigate complaint C-16-02389. The complaint refers to strong metallic/rust/acidic odors allegedly generated by Howard Finishing, observed on the afternoon of September 17<sup>th</sup> at 32565 Dequindre, Madison Heights, Mi. ## Inspection

Site arrival was at 8:25am Tuesday October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2016. The weather conditions were 56F and foggy with 2-4 mph winds from the northeast. Using flags I was able to visually confirm the wind direction. Howard Finishing is located in a primarily industrial area with the complainants business approximately 490ft south of the facility. I drove around the complainant's location as follows:

I did not observe any distinguishable industrial odors during my investigation. During my previous inspection of Howard Finishing, Jeff Mertz Director of New Business indicated that he would ask employees if they had observed any odors related to acidic/rust/metallic odors. On 10/10/2016 Jeff forwarded the AQD two photos one of his employees took. The employee indicated that the photos were taken from Howard Finishing's property. He stated that Diamabrush 32470 Industrial Dr, Madison Heights, MI 48071 (SRN N6434) emitted what appeared to be either smoke or water vapor for approximately 3 minutes once every few weeks. When this occurred and the weather conditions were right, he observed a very strong odor which he describes as smelling like a hot electric motor. He also stated that the odor could linger for a long period of time, and it made it difficult for him to breathe. The employee's statements appear to be consistent with the observations of the complainant.

## Conclusion

The source of the odor has not been determined. Photos and further information suggests that

Diamabrush SRN N6434 may be the source of the odors. Diamabrush should be inspected to determine if they have a process that is generating the odors. /
