VIOLATION NOTICE

On February 11, 2014, staff of the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD) observed visible emissions from Lansing Board of Water and Light (LBWL) Eckert Station located at 601 Island Avenue in Lansing and subsequently received an opacity report on February 12, 2014, for Boiler Units 1-6. The opacity report indicated the following violation occurred on February 11, 2014, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.
