#### Inspection Summary

This was a self-initiated inspection due name confusion between MACES and MAERS. A note in MACES from a phone conversation between Dan McGeen and Troy Angst on 2/28/2012 stated that they did not have any emission units associated with PTI 121-96 on the property or in the building. I completed this inspection to confirm the emission units associated with PTI 121-96 were removed with intent to void the permit if so.

PTI 121-96 lists the following emission units:

- 1. One Paint Booth
- 2. One Varnish Dip and Bake Oven
- 3. One Cold Cleaner

The permit was issued to MagneTek on July 30, 1996. Since this time, the building has transferred ownership

numerous times.

I arrived around 1010 and went to the front office. I asked for a manager or the owner while introducing myself and explaining the intent of my visit to Nancy. Nancy stated that they did not have any production onsite and did not have any paint booths as listed in the permit. She called Scott Schneider to the office and asked him to walk me around to confirm the removal of the equipment.

Scott and I walked around the entire facility. I did not find the paint booths yet did find the ductwork that led to a filtration system for the painting operations. Scott stated that the equipment had been removed prior to them taking over ownership of the building. Heat was provided by natural gas "Reznor" heating units for the facility and they did not have any boilers or other emission sources.

Upon completion of our walk through, I informed Nancy and Scott that I would be voiding permit PTI 121-96 since it no longer applied to the facility. Nancy gave me a contact of Andrew Brandes, 200 Universal Dr, Owosso, MI 48867 for notification once the permit void was complete.

I left the site around 1045 after finding no concerns.

A copy of this activity report will be forwarded to the MDEQ AQD Permit Section as per the procedures listed in "Procedure for Voiding Permits to Install" dated June 7, 1999. Following the completion of the void, I will contact Mr. Brandes as stated above.
