VIOLATION NOTICE

On October 30, 2013, the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division (MDEQ-AQD) received from DTE Energy Services, located at 4490 North River Road, East China, Michigan, its Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) Semi-Annual Report Certification. The Certification was due by September 15, 2013. The purpose of these reports is to demonstrate compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act. 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules, and the Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) number MI-ROP-B2796-2009a (Section 5).

The alleged violation includes the following:

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by November 25, 2013. The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If DTE Energy Services believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
