Scheduled inspection with Jerry Woods.

Asphalt plant not yet operational this season due to the unusally longl, cold winter.

Woods and his staff are currently working on erecting the extensions to the silo unloading truck enclosure that they discussed last season to upgrade their capture and control of fugitive blue smoke and asphalt odors associated with their current enclosure.

The extensions are about 20 ft. in length on the north end, where the trucks enter the enclosure, and about 40 ft. off the south end, where the trucks exit the enclosure. Woods will be attaching pole-building type corrugated sheet steel to the peaked roof, the top third of the sides, and the bottom third of the sidewalls, with the middle third of the sidewalls to be see-through plexiglass sheeting.

Apparently they have also designed vinyl sheeting doors for the north end that will be capable of opening and closing.

All in all this appears to be a significant improvement in mitigating the fugitive asphalt odors that tend to funnel out of the enclosure from the loading of trucks, particularly when there is a southerly component to the wind direction.

The frost law weight restrictions have not yet been lifted off the Class A roads. Woods expects they will start up in next couple of weeks.
