**Introduction**

On November 3, 2022, State of Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy Air Quality Division (AQD) staff member Scott Evans (SE) conducted an air quality inspection of the Port City Paints facility located at 1250 9<sup>th</sup> St. in Muskegon, Michigan, to assess compliance with air quality rules and regulations. This facility is classified as a minor source of criteria pollutants and has no active permits to install (PTIs). This is a paint recycling and manufacturing site that produces and sells latex paint products.

**Inspection**

Upon arrival at the facility, there were no observed odors or visible emissions during an initial inspection of the facility perimeter. After entering the facility, SE was greeted by David Sumner II (DS). After a brief discussion of the purpose of the visit, an inspection of the facility was conducted.

During the inspection it was observed that all paint manufacturing and recycling equipment had been removed from the facility. Any operations at the facility other than mixing of paints to specific colors for customers have been moved to another facility located in Holland, Mi.

**Conclusion**

At the time of the inspection the facility had no applicable air quality regulations requiring inspection. It is recommended at this time that the facility be removed from AQD overste.
