Inspection Narrative:

The facility has been idled / shutdown for several years, as the District staff received confirmation of this operational status on October 11, 2011. The facility's management chose to keep its permit active pending any future decision to reopen. The facility still submits an annual MAERS report, that indicates zero emissions because it still has an active permit and is classified as a Fee Category II source. The MAERS Emission Report for 2014 was reviewed and was attached to this report.

On November 24, 2015, I drove by the facility and observed that it remains locked and unmanned. The storage tanks exhibited rust on the tank exteriors, as indicated by Figure 1.

On December 3, 2015, the facility's new contact person provided me with a statement (attached) that the facility remains closed pending a future decision to resume activity / operation at this location. I updated MACES with Lee Ann Beck's contact information.
