ENFORCEMENT NOTICE

In the matter of:

Davison Cleaners 2051 Davison Road Detroit, MI 48238

Establishment No.: 8200062; Wayne County

This letter is to advise you of the commencement of escalated enforcement action against Davison Cleaners for violations that occurred at its dry cleaner establishment located at 2051 Davison Road in Detroit, Michigan. This letter follows the Violation Notices issued by the Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division (AQD), on April 6, 2015 and April 28, 2015, that outlines the alleged violations. This enforcement notice is for operating a dry cleaning establishment without a dry cleaning license, not paying the Dry Cleaning license fees and Air Quality fees, and also failing to comply with the National Perchloroethylene Air Emission Standards for Dry Cleaning Facilities, Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 63, Subpart M.

AQD is hereby providing the company with an opportunity to meet to discuss options for satisfactorily resolving the mentioned violation, to demonstrate compliance, and to present factual information in writing that should be considered regarding the violation. This proposed resolution would include, among other things, a compliance schedule and an appropriate monetary penalty. Please contact me no later than Monday, June 8, 2015, to schedule a meeting to discuss the resolution of this matter.

Be advised that failure to respond to this Enforcement Notice and adequately resolve or address the cited violation may result in further enforcement proceedings, including, but not limited to, referral of the matter to the Michigan Department of Attorney General for commencement of civil litigation. Be further advised, that this Enforcement Notice does not preclude or limit the AQD's ability to initiate any other enforcement action under federal or state law as appropriate.
