Purpose:

Perform an unannounced scheduled compliance inspection of Agri-Sales grain elevator, M1906, which does not have a permit. The site was last investigated in 2008 by Ken Terry and marked temporarily closed. This visit's main goal is to determine if Agri-Sales should be marked "permanently closed" in MACES.

Inspection:

Kim Sakowski and l'arrived at the site of the Agri-Sales grain elevator at approximately 11:30 a.m. July 24, 2014. There was a building, which looked like a residential home, on the property. There was a rusted, worn-down sign "Agri-Sales" on the side of one of the grain elevator's structures. It appeared that the grain elevator's loading tunnels were now being used to house or shelter cars. The railroad tracks which were presumably once used to loadout grain from the elevator are no longer usable/in service. The tracks have been removed where Pingree Road runs through. The grain elevator structures (bucket legs, conveyors, rail loadout spouts, etc in and around the elevator) did not appear to be maintained, and there were no signs of business being conducted while onsite.

I have spoken with Kathy Brewer in the Bay City office, who also has Agri-Sales sources, to find out who the contact would be to speak with concerning this Agri-Sales site, but she was unable to find a specific contact.

I have marked Agri-Sales as "Permanently Closed" in MACES.
