RE: RESPONSE OF DETROIT RENEWABLE POWER TO VIOLATION NOTICE DATED JUNE 29, 2015 ISSUED BY THE AIR QUALITY DIVISION

Dear Ms. Zhu:

Detroit Renewable Power ("DRP") submits this response to the June 29, 2015 Violation Notice ("VN") issued by the Air Quality Division ("AQD") of the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality received via e-mail on July 24, 2015. The VN alleges that DRP violated ROP No. MI-ROP-M4148-2011, Table FGBOILERS011-013, Condition I.9

In the normal course of business, DRP provided an explanation for this exceedance within the submission of the Quarterly Excess Emission and Monitoring Systems Performance Report (first quarter of 2015) and again in an e-mail dated June 17, 2015 (copy attached).

In addition to the information previously provided as noted above, our internal investigation revealed that DRP's Shift Supervisor initial reaction time, in both incidences was not adequate. The individual's delay in response time for the appropriate corrective action led to the 24 hour exceedance. The responsible supervisor no longer is employed with DRP.

We trust that this letter provides a satisfactory response to the June 29, 2015 VN, but please contact me if you have additional questions or comments. We would be more than willing to meet with you or other AQD personnel at any time to discuss this response.
