On Thursday, October 17, 2019, Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy-Air Quality Division (EGLE-AQD) staff, I, Adam Bognar, conducted a scheduled inspection of Sheraton Southfield Hotel located at 16400 J L Hudson Drive, Southfield, MI 48075. The purpose of this inspection was to determine the facility's compliance status with the Federal Clean Air Act; Article II, Part 55, Air Pollution Control of Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 Public Act 451; Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy-Air Quality Division (EGLE-AQD) rules; and Permit to Install No. 414-88.

I arrived at this location at around 2 pm.

The building at this address is vacant. It is a relatively large 15 floor hotel building that reads "Plaza Hotel & Convention Center". The doors and windows are boarded up and I did not see any evidence of construction. An article online states that there may be plans to reopen the hotel in the future (see link below).

Permit to install No. 414-88 was issued to this facility under the name "Michigan Inn" in 1989 for one 12.5 MMBTU/hr natural gas and No. 6 fuel oil fired boiler. I was not able to verify if this boiler is still in the hotel.
