RE: FCA US LLC (FCA) – Detroit Assembly Complex Mack, SRN: N2155 Response to Violation Notice

Dear Mr. Byrnes:

This letter responds to AQD's November 3, 2021 Violation Notice ("VN"), which alleged noncompliance with General Condition No. 6 of Permit to Install No 14-19a (an "unreasonable interference with the comfortable enjoyment of life and property") due to the presence of nuisance odors observed by Air Quality Division ("AQD") staff on October 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021 in the area near the Detroit Assembly Complex Mack ("Mack") facility.

The allegations made in the VN are similar to those made by AQD in its September 20, 2021 Violation Notice. Accordingly, FCA logged the October 28, 2021 observation made by AQD and is including the additional information in its comprehensive review of odor data.

As previously documented, FCA has undertaken extensive work to characterize the potential sources of odor from the facility and evaluate the impact of those sources on odor observed outside the Mack facility. That work remains on schedule and will result in the identification of specific actions to be taken to mitigate the presence of odors in the nearby community. As committed in our response to the September 20<sup>th</sup> Violation Notice, FCA is working urgently to provide the results of our investigation and our plan for mitigating odor with AQD and the community no later than January 9, 2022. Given the similarities between the two violation notices, our plan to implement odor control measures will address allegations made in both violation notices. FCA commits to continuing its efforts to identify and address potential sources of objectionable odor.
