Thank you for your recent visit. Feel free to stop in and inspect our operation any time you are in the area. We take pride in maintaining a clean and well organized operation.

In the past we worked with Jennifer Dixon. Our practice to have the operators monitor and document oven operations has been acceptable. That being said, we invested in temperature recorders on three of our ovens and during your visit we were in the process of installing two additional chart recorders.

With respect to BO4, we found the pen was misaligned and reading low. The afterburner was operating above 1400 degrees.

The chart recorder for BO 1 was in the process of being installed to provide for more accurate measurements and records of the oven operation.

At this time all of the afterburners have been set to a minimum temperature of 1405 degrees.

It is the operator's responsibility to monitor the condition of the ovens during processing and report any problems. On a daily basis it is the responsibility of the production controller to review the charts and take action when an out of control condition is found or reported.
