## **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On January 10, 2019, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division, conducted an inspection of the Medical Arts Center Building located at 335 East Houghton Street, West Branch, Michigan 48661. The Notification of Intent to Renovate/Demolish indicated the abatement contractor for the planned renovation project was HBC Specialized Contracting, the waste transporter was American Waste and the disposal site was the Northern Oaks Recycling and Disposal Facility. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M; Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended; and the conditions of Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) number MI-ROP-N6010-2018.

According to our investigation, the waste transporter, American Waste, lost 93 asbestos waste bags on January 9, 2018, on the southbound I-75 exit 215 ramp, after departing the Medical Arts Center Building and before arriving at the Northern Oaks Recycling and Disposal Facility.

Failure to reconcile the discrepancy between the quantity of waste designated on the waste shipment records and the quantity actually received.	40 CFR 61.145(e)(3)	Upon discovering a discrepancy between the quantity of waste designated on the waste shipment records and the quantity actually received, no attempt was made to reconcile the discrepancy with the waste generator.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a signed written response to this Violation Notice by February 5, 2019 (which coincides with 21

calendar days from the date of this letter). The response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
