## VIOLATION NOTICE

On November 2, 2018, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Aristo Industries located at 24951 Henry B Joy Road, Harrison Township, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Aristo Industries' compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the Air Pollution Control Rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 21-01B;

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Process Description	Rule/Permit Condition Violated	Comments
FGFACILITY	PTI No. 21-01B SC 3.4, 3.5, 3.6	The permittee failed to keep monthly records of gallons or pounds of VOC and HAP containing materials used, HAP content of the materials used, VOC and HAP (individual and aggregate) emission calculations determined monthly in tons per month and VOC and HAP emission calculations determining annual emission rate in tons per 12-month rolling time period as determined at the end of each calendar month.
FG-PlasmaCutters	PTI No. 21-01B SC 2.7, 2.8, 2.9	The permittee failed to keep log of operating hours for the plasma cutters, daily pressure drop readings (when operating) and weekly visible emission readings.

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During this inspection, Aristo Industries was unable to produce emission records. This is a violation of (the recordkeeping and emission limitations) specified in Special Condition 2.7, 2.8, 2.9, 3.5 and 3.6 of PTI number 21-01B.

The conditions of PTI number 21-01B require maintenance of records, which shall be made available for review upon request by the AQD staff.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by January 31, 2019 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

Please submit the written response to the DEQ, AQD, Southeast Michigan District, at 27700 Donald Court, Warren, Michigan 48092 and submit a copy to Ms. Jenine Camilleri, Enforcement Unit Supervisor at the DEQ, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760.

If Aristo Industries believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
