## **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On September 3, 2015, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of Century Foundry, Inc. located at 339 West Hovey Avenue, Muskegon Heights, Michigan. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Century Foundry, Inc.'s compliance with the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451); the administrative rules; and the conditions of Permit to Install (PTI) number 43-05A.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

Electric Induction Furnaces (Plant 2)	PTI No. 43-05A FGPT2FURN1-2-3-4-5 SC 5.4	Failure to maintain material usage records.
Electric Induction Furnaces (Plant 2)	PTI No. 43-05A FGPT2FURN6-7 SC 6.4	Failure to maintain material usage records.

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Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by October 21, 2015. The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Century Foundry, Inc. believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
