## VIOLATION NOTICE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division (AQD), reviewed the quarterly excess emission report submitted by Graymont Western Lime, Inc., located at 181 West County Road 432, in Gulliver, Michigan. The Renewable Operating Permit number MI-ROP-N7362-2015 requires the facility to monitor and record carbon monoxide from EU KILN#1 on a continuous basis in a manner and with instrumentation acceptable to the AQD.

The first guarter 2016 excess emission report indicated that there was an extended period of monitor downtime. Specifically, the carbon monoxide monitor downtime was reported at 25.8% of the operating time for the quarter.

During the review, staff noted the following:

Please initiate the actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by June 24, 2016 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
