As we discussed today, Tom is in North Carolina until November 18th.

As far as the temperature violation goes, we have contacted Honeywell to come out and assess the issue of not getting up to the 1600 degree according to PTI 206-16 regulations.

On the stack height, the regulation says 32 feet. We purchased the oven from Arnet's in Ann Arbor and just figured that since they ran the oven for 17 years, that the stack met code. We will be asking the appropriate department for a variance on stack height.

I have started the process with scheduling Honeywell to come out. The stack issue will have to wait for Honeywell's assessment on the temperature issue.
