Greetings. As you are aware, I am General Counsel for various companies, including 3401 Martin Properties, LLC and Fiore Enterprises, LLC. I am in receipt of your correspondence dated March 28, 2017, regarding the equipment previously located at 3401 Martin Detroit, MI 48210.

As a follow-up to our conversation on March 23, 2017, Fiore Enterprises, LLC purchased the portable crushing equipment in question from a defunct business in Florida. Upon purchase, the company placed the portable crushing into storage. Within the last two months, the company brought all of the pieces of the portable crusher to the 3401 Martin location, in order to examine whether or not the company has all of the equipment necessary to know if the machine will actually work. To date, it appears that the machine does not work. The equipment has been taken apart and most of it has been removed from the property at 3401 Martin. Thus, the equipment in question is not the source of an air contaminant at this time.

In the future, if Fiore Enterprises, LLC does wish to attempt to make the portable crusher work, it will first obtain a permit from the MDEQ. In addition, thank you for providing the materials regarding the permits in question. I will continue to monitor this matter and keep you updated.
