On November 29, 2018, I conducted a level 2 self-initiated inspection at Advanced Assembly Products, Inc. (AAP) located at 1300 E. Nine Mile Road, Hazel Park, Michigan 48030. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the facility's compliance with the requirements of the Federal Clean Air Act; Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451), and the Administrative Rules. Ms. Christine (Chris) Hess, Director of Human Resources for AAP facilities, is my facility contact for this site and the AAP Madison Heights facility. Per Ms. Hess, AAP conducts the metal fabrication processes at the Chesterfield facility, including the operations previously conducted at the AAP Madison Heights facility. She maintains an office in both the Chesterfield and Hazel Park facilities. I also conducted inspection at the AAP Madison Heights facility following the Hazel Park facility. Please see per Activity Report No. P084147098 for the Madison Heights inspection. Ms. Christine Hess and Ms. Allison Hess accompanied me during the walk-through inspection for both facilities. At the AAP Hazel Park facility, I also met Mr. Steve Halcomb, Production Supervisor.

AAP manufactures automotive metal parts and supplies these parts as OE, Tire One, or Tier Two Supplier for the automotive industry. The products are: interior components - O/H structures, center console, IP structures; closure systems - hinges, strikes, latches; chassis components - bracketry, end caps, heat shields. The operations include pressing, machining, welding, drilling, routing, etc., and assembly. Ms. Christine Hess mentioned that AAP's main client is General Motors.

During the walk-through inspection of the AAP Hazel Park facility, I observed mostly assembly operations. The facility was conducting assembly operations for the production of hinges. I observed several equipment stations utilized to assemble metal parts to produce various types of hinges. Per Ms. Hess, the production of the various components for the hinge assembly are all outsourced. Some of the parts are coming from the Chesterfield facility. I did not observe any boilers, parts washers, and/or stacks while inside the facility. Any potential air related emissions are exhausted indoors.

Overall, I did not find any noncompliance issues during inspection.
