VIOLATION NOTICE

On February 27, 2017, the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Air Quality Division, performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) investigation at 1364 East Bristol Road, Burton, Genesee County. The purpose of this investigation was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

According to my investigation, Mr. David Yono, of Mr. Klean, owns the subject commercial facility, Bedient Construction performed the demolition activities at this facility and BBMK Contracting was the general contractor overseeing the project. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the owner and the operator equally liable for the violations.

During the investigation, staff observed the following: The former commercial property was demolished and the site was cleared and graded. The liable parties had failed to provide a 10-working day notice to the administrator prior to the demolition activities.

The written response should include: the date(s) the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
