### VIOLATION NOTICE

On June 2, 2022, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted a complaint investigation at 3509 Corunna Road, Flint Township, Genesee County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to my investigation, Bazo Construction, owns the facility being demolished and was also the contractor performing the demolition activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos (NESHAP) holds the *owner and operator* liable for all violations.

During the inspection, EGLE staff observed the following:

The former commercial gas station and single residential home were demolished, and the demolition debris was left staged on-site. No thorough asbestos inspection was completed and no Notice of Intent to Renovate/Demolish was submitted to the administrator prior to the demolition activities.

If you believe the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute a violation of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
