VIOLATION NOTICE

On October 17, 2019, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) investigation at 2531 West Main Street, Lowell, Kent County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

According to my investigation, Denker Management, LLC owns the subject facility and CL Trucking & Excavating, LLC, performed the demolition activities. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the *owner and operator* equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

The subject facility was in the process of being demolished and the construction debris was being loaded-out for disposal. A notification was submitted to the Department of Labor & Economic Growth (LEO) for the removal of the asbestos containing material by Prime Contracting, LLC. However, no Notification of Intent to Renovate/Demolish was submitted to EGLE-AQD for the scheduled demolition activities.
