VIOLATION NOTICE

On January 16, 2020, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) performed an asbestos NESHAP (National Emission Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants) inspection at 316 East Main Street, Howell, Livingston County. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR), Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451).

According to my investigation, Mr. Pete Coratti owns the subject facility. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the *owner and operator* equally liable for any violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

The subject former commercial facility was in the process of being renovated. The owner failed to have a thorough asbestos inspection done on the facility prior to any of the renovation activities.

Performed a drive-by inspection on the subject facility located at 316 East Main Street, Howell. The owner did not have an asbestos survey done prior to the renovation activities.	40 CFR 61.145 (a)	Failure to thoroughly inspect.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a written response to this violation notice by February 17, 2020, (which coincides with 21

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calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
