## **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On February 26, 2016 and March 15, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division, conducted an investigation of the residential properties located at 5816-18 Beechwood, 14558 Griggs, and 15736 West Parkway, Detroit. The purpose of this investigation was to determine the Detroit Land Bank Authority's, RDC Construction Services, LLC's, the Detroit Building Authority's and the City of Detroit Office of Contracting and Procurement's compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, RDC Construction Services, LLC performed the demolition activities at the asbestos-NESHAP subject properties. The properties are owned by the Detroit Land Bank, the City of Detroit Office of Contracting and Procurement was the contract holder for the demolition, and the Detroit Building Authority oversaw the demolition. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds the owner and operators equally liable for violations.

RDC Construction Services, LLC was requested to provide documentation pertaining to the demolition on 5816-18 Beechwood on February 26, 2016. During the review it was noted that the house had been demolished several weeks prior to the notification start date of October 29, 2015. On March 15, 2016, it was discovered that several homes had been demolished without the submittal of a 10 day notification to the DEQ AQD.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a written response to this Violation Notice by April 12, 2016 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If the Detroit Land Bank, RDC Construction Services, LLC, the Detroit Building Authority, and/or City of Detroit Office of Contracting and Procurement believe the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.

Thank you for your attention to resolving the violations cited above and for the cooperation that was extended to me during my investigation of the sites.
