SECOND VIOLATION NOTICE

On February 26, 2016 and March 15, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division, conducted an investigation of the residential properties located at 5816-18 Beechwood, 14558 Griggs, and 15736 West Parkway, Detroit. The purpose of this investigation was to determine the Detroit Land Bank Authority's, RDC Construction Services, LLC's, the Detroit Building Authority's and the City of Detroit Office of Contracting and Procurement's compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

On March 22, 2016, the AQD sent the company a Violation Notice citing violations discovered as a result of the inspections and requested your written response by April 12, 2016. A copy of that letter is enclosed for your reference. As of this date, we have not received your response.

Please be advised that failure to respond in writing and identifying actions the company will take or has taken to resolve the cited violations may result in escalated enforcement action by the AQD. Please provide the information requested in our March 22, 2016 letter by April 28, 2016, which corresponds to 14 days from the date of this letter.

Be further advised that issuance of this Violation Notice does not preclude or limit the DEQ's ability to initiate any other enforcement action under state or federal law as appropriate.
