## **VIOLATION NOTICE**

On August 31, 2017, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division, conducted an inspection of the facility located at 9208-12 Michigan Avenue, Detroit. The purpose of this inspection was to determine Mr. Mohamed Elsharnoby and Affordable Excavating's compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 61, Subpart M (National Emission Standard for Asbestos), and Rule 942 of Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, Mr. Mohamed Elsharnoby owns the facility and Affordable Excavating performed the demolition activities at the facility. The National Emission Standard for Asbestos holds both the owner and operator equally liable for violations.

During the inspection, staff observed that the building had been demolished without submittal of a 10 day notification of intent to renovate/demolish. The building was determined by The City of Detroit to be in imminent danger of collapse and therefore a "Notice of Emergency Ordered Demolition" letter was issued on August 15, 2017. As such, all NESHAP requirements for an ordered demolition must be met.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and <u>submit a written</u> <u>response to this Violation Notice by October 23, 2017</u> (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include:

- Submit a copy of the Notification of Intent to Renovate/Demolish for activities associated with the referenced violation;
- The dates the violation(s) occurred;
- An explanation of the causes and duration of the violations(s);
- Whether the violation(s) are ongoing;
- A summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation(s) and the dates by which these actions will take place; and
- What steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

If Mr. Mohamed Elsharnoby or Affordable Excavating believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
