VIOLATION NOTICE

On October 15, 2019, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of the properties located at

- 4912 Livernois, Detroit, MI 48210 SRN# U821909929
- 4918 Livernois, Detroit, MI 48210 SRN# U821909930

The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M and Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, Zead Rammoui owns the properties and Direct Construction Services, LLC performed the demolition activities at the properties. The NESHAP for Asbestos holds both the owner and operator equally liable for violations.

During the inspection, AQD staff observed the following:

An active demolition project of three (3) adjacent residential properties owned by the same individual. There was no Notice of Intent to Renovate/Demolish on file and the owner of the demolition company stated that there was no asbestos survey completed for the properties.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a signed written response to this Violation Notice by November 25, 2019 (which coincides with 21

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calendar days from the date of this letter). The response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
