On September 9, 2020, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD) conducted an inspection of a vacant residence located at 19 Myrtle St., River Rouge, MI, 48218. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M and Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

VIOLATION NOTICE

According to our investigation, the Wayne County Land Bank owns the facility and LGC Global, Inc. performed the renovation activities at the facility. The NESHAP for Asbestos holds both the owner and operator equally liable for violations.

During the inspection, staff observed the following:

During a notified abatement of plaster within the home, friable plaster debris was observed remaining on the floor, and the plaster debris was dry at the time of inspection. Upon checking the dumpster, none of the waste bags had the proper labelling affixed and many had holes/tears in them. Plaster was observed on the floor of the dumpster in a dry state.

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Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violations and submit a signed written response to this Violation Notice by October 29, 2020 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The response should include: the dates the violations occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violations; whether the violations are ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violations and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
