VIOLATION NOTICE

On December 16, 2020, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of the Bayview Yacht Club located at 100 Clairpointe, Detroit. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M and Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, the Bayview Yacht Club owns the facility and Pro Touch Construction performed the partial demolition activities at the facility. Frank Rewold & Sons, Inc. is the general contractor for the project. The NESHAP for Asbestos holds the owner and operators liable for violations.

AQD staff observed that the clubhouse had been partially demolished. A copy of the asbestos survey and the 10-day notice of intent were requested for the project. An asbestos survey had been conducted for the clubhouse. However, the required a 10-day notice of intent to demolish had not been submitted for partial demolition of the building.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a signed written response to this Violation Notice by February 25, 2021 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The response should include: the dates the violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
