VIOLATION NOTICE

On February 9 and March 10, 2022, the Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Air Quality Division (AQD), conducted an inspection of the residential property located at 181 W. Nevada, Detroit. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with the requirements of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 61, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), Subpart M and Rule 942 of the administrative rules promulgated under Part 55, Air Pollution Control of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended.

According to our investigation, the Detroit Land Bank Authority owns the residential property. The structure was to be demolished by the Detroit Demolition Department as part of the City of Detroit's blight program.

On February 8, 2022, the AQD was notified by the Detroit Demolition Department and their associated demolition contractor that the house had had been discovered in a pile. The structure had demolished at some point after asbestos abatement but before the post abatement verification could be conducted. AQD staff went by the site and noted the waste pile was wetted and covered in preparation for removal and disposal by the Detroit Demolition Department.

Please initiate actions necessary to correct the cited violation and submit a signed written response to this Violation Notice by June 7, 2022 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The response should include: the dates the

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violation occurred; an explanation of the causes and duration of the violation; whether the violation is ongoing; a summary of the actions that have been taken and are proposed to be taken to correct the violation and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
