Thank you for your interest regarding the Permit to Install application submitted by Genesee Power Station to the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) requesting a modification to add tire derived fuel as a supplemental fuel for the existing boiler for the facility located at G-5310 North Dort Highway, Flint, Michigan.

Pursuant to state and federal requirements, the MDEQ held a public comment period that ended with a public hearing on April 28, 2011, on its proposed conditional approval of the permit. The Air Quality Division (AQD) received one written comment during the public comment period and seven verbal comments were presented at the public hearing.

After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of the DEQ, I have approved Permit to Install No. 265-06C.
