This letter is in reference to your Permit to Install (PTI) application identified as No. 27-17 (State Registration Number B7248) for a new automotive paint line, a spray-on truck bedliner facility, and a storage warehouse. The paint line will be located in the main assembly plant at 38111 Van Dyke Road, Sterling Heights, Michigan. The spray-on truck bedliner facility will be located at 7566 Metropolitan Parkway, Sterling Heights, Michigan, directly across the street from the main plant. The storage warehouse will be located across 17 Mile Road, approximately one half mile north of the northern boundary of the main plant.

The public comment period ended on May 12, 2017. A public hearing was not requested. The Air Quality Division (AQD) received seven (7) comments during the comment period.

After careful consideration of the issues and pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), I have approved PTI No. 27-17. As a part of this approval, we have revised the permit conditions to address certain information received during the public participation process and the subsequent analysis of that information.

The AQD has prepared the enclosed Response to Comments (RTC) document, which provides our responses to comments received during the public comment period. It also identifies the special conditions that have been modified and provides our rationale for modifying the proposed special conditions. These changes are listed in Section II of the RTC document.

This approval is based upon and subject to compliance with all administrative rules of the MDEQ and conditions stipulated in the enclosed supplement. Please review these conditions thoroughly so that you may take the actions necessary to ensure compliance with all of these conditions.

The equipment covered by this permit is also subject to the requirements of the Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) Program. Submittal of the M-001 and C-001 forms may be required prior to commencing operation. A change that is subject to Rule 215 subrules (1), (2), or (3), promulgated pursuant to Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, requires the submittal of the forms to the appropriate AQD District Office. If a change is made pursuant to Rule 216, please submit the required forms to the Cadillac District Office at the address provided in the M-001 form instructions. Also, you must notify the Southeast Michigan District Office, in writing, within 30 days after completion of the installation, construction, reconstruction, relocation, or modification of the process or process equipment covered by this PTI.
