This letter is in reference to your Permit to Install application identified as No. 293-09A (State Registration Number N5986) for two new landfill gas fired internal combustion engines and electric generator sets located at 28800 Clark Road, New Boston, Michigan.

The public comment period ended on June 27, 2011. No comments were received nor was a request for a public hearing made during this period. Pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), I have approved Permit to Install No. 293-09A.

This approval is based upon and subject to compliance with all administrative rules of the MDEQ and conditions stipulated in the enclosed supplement. Please review these conditions thoroughly so that you may take the actions necessary to ensure compliance with all of these conditions.

The equipment covered by this permit is also subject to the requirements of the Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) Program. Submittal of the M-001 and C-001 forms may be required prior to commencing operation. A change that is subject to Rule 215 subrules (1), (2), or (3), promulgated pursuant to Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, requires the submittal of the forms to the appropriate AQD District Office. If a change is made pursuant to Rule 216, please submit the required forms to the Air Quality Division (AQD) Permit Section.
