Dear Mr. Warner:

This letter is in reference to Permit No. 317-07, State Registration Number N7867, for Wolverine Power Supply Cooperative, Inc. (Wolverine), for a 600 megawatt (MW) coal-fired steam electric power plant proposed to be located in Rogers City, Michigan.

It has come to our attention that the final permit conditions issued on June 29, 2011, contained several unintended errors. These errors have been corrected and revised permit conditions have been issued. Please note that the errors were administrative in nature. The correct language was listed in the special conditions as they were presented for public comment on April 13, 2011, as well as referenced in the response to comments document issued June 29, 2011. The corrections include the following:


1. For FGCFB flexible group emission limits for VOC on page 26, Special Condition (SC) I.17 and I.18, in the Monitoring/Testing Method column SC VI.11 was changed to SC VI.12 to correspond to the correct monitoring requirement.
2. For FGCFB flexible group Material Limits on page 27, SC II.3, the language "include a minimum of 5%, but no more than..." was added to the condition.
3. For FGCFB flexible group Testing/Sampling on page 30, SC V.3, the language "and PM2.5..." was added to the condition to verify PM2.5 emission rates.
4. For FGCFB flexible group Monitoring/Recordkeeping on page 31, SC VI.6, the language "as described in Emission Limit SC I.5, I.6, and I.7.", was changed to reference the correct special conditions of SC I.8 and 1.9.
5. For FGCFB flexible group Monitoring/Recordkeeping on page 31, SC VI.7, the language "as described in Emission Limit SC I.8.", was changed to reference the correct special condition of SC I.10.
6. For FGCFB flexible group Monitoring/Recordkeeping on page 31, SC VI.8, the language "as described in Emission Limit SC I.9, I.10, and I.11.", was changed to reference the correct special conditions of SC I.11 and 1.12.
7. For FGCFB flexible group Monitoring/Recordkeeping on page 31, SC VI.9, the language "as Emission Limit SC I.12, I.13, I.14, I.15, and I.16.", was changed to include "described in" and reference the correct special conditions of SC I.13, I.14, and 1.15.

8. For FGCFB flexible group Monitoring/Recordkeeping on page 32, SC VI.10, the language "as described in Emission Limit SC I.17.", was changed to reference the correct special condition of SC I.16.
9. For FGCFB flexible group Monitoring/Recordkeeping on page 32, SC VI.11, the language "as described in Emission Limit SC I.26.", was changed to reference the correct special condition of SC I.24.
10. For EULIMESTONE, EULIMESTONEPREP, EUBEDASH, EUFLYASH, EUSOLIDFUELHANDLING, EUFUELCRUSHER, and EUFUELSILO Emission Limits on pages 34 - 52, the PM10/PM2.5 emission limits were separated as two separate limits, as was stated in the response to comments document that "Emission limits were added for PM2.5 to all emission units which have PM10 limits."

Approval of this permit is based on and subject to compliance with the administrative rules of the Department of Environmental Quality and the conditions stipulated in the enclosed revised supplement to the permit dated July 12, 2011. Please review these revised conditions thoroughly so that you may take the actions necessary to ensure compliance with all of the conditions.
