This letter is in reference to your Permit to Install application identified as No. 63-11 (State Registration Number B2816) for the installation of process equipment associated with the Reduced Emission Fuel system demonstration project for the facility located at 3500 East Front Street, Monroe, Michigan.

The public comment period ended on July 13, 2011. No comments were received nor was a request for a public hearing made during this period. Pursuant to the delegation of authority from the Director of the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), I have approved Permit to Install No. 63-11.

The equipment covered by this permit is also subject to the requirements of the Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) Program. Submittal of the M-001 and C-001 forms may be required prior to commencing operation. A change that is subject to Rule 215 subrules (1), (2), or (3), promulgated pursuant to Part 55, Air Pollution Control, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended, requires the submittal of the forms to the appropriate Air Quality Division (AQD) District Office. If a change is made pursuant to Rule 216, please submit the required forms to the AQD Permit Section.
