

NOTICE of AIR POLLUTION COMMENT PERIOD and PUBLIC HEARING

The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) is holding a public comment period from July 19, 2017, until August 18, 2017, and a public hearing, if requested, on August 23, 2017, for EES Coke Battery LLC's proposed temporary controlled venting of an existing 300,000 gallon light oil storage tank. The temporary controlled venting will be for a maximum of 30 days. The facility is located at 1400 Zug Island Road, River Rouge, Michigan. The public comment period and hearing, if requested, are to allow all interested parties the opportunity to comment on the MDEQ's proposed conditional approval of a Permit to Install (PTI). It has been preliminarily determined that the temporary controlled venting of the existing tank will not violate any of the MDEQ's rules nor the National Ambient Air Quality Standards.

All statements received by August 18, 2017 will be considered by the decision-maker prior to final permit action. If a hearing is requested, the comment period will be extended until the close of the hearing.

Only if requested in writing by August 18, 2017, the informational session and public hearing will be held on August 23, 2017 at the City Hall Council Chambers Room, 10600 West Jefferson Avenue, River Rouge, Michigan. The informational session will begin at 6:00 p.m.; at which time AQD staff will be available to answer questions. The public hearing will begin at 7:00 p.m. The sole purpose of the public hearing will be to take formal testimony on the record. Those interested may contact the AQD at 517-284-6805 on August 21, 2017, to determine if a hearing was requested and will be held.
