Dear Interested Party:

This letter is in reference to a Permit to Install application from DTE Energy proposing to modify the stack height on the five (5) existing diesel generators located at the Detroit Edison - Monroe Power Plant on 3500 East Front Street, Monroe, Michigan. The Permit to Install application is identified as No. 93-09B.

The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) has announced a public comment period on the draft permit conditions, as required by state and federal regulations. The public comment period is to solicit written comments prior to making a final decision on the permit application. Written comments received during the comment period will be considered in the final permit decision. Please mail comments by January 18, 2012, to Ms. Mary Ann Dolehanty, Permit Section Supervisor, DEQ, Air Quality Division, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan, 48909-7760. Comments may also be submitted from the webpage <http://www.deq.state.mi.us/aps/cwerp.shtml> (click on "Submit Comment" under the DTE Energy, Permit to Install Application No. 93-09B listing).

If a public hearing is requested in writing by January 18, 2012, a public hearing will be held on January 23, 2012, in the Lillian Hatcher Conference Room, Constitution Hall, 525 West Allegan Street, 3rd Floor, North Tower, Lansing, Michigan. The sole purpose of the hearing will be to take formal testimony on the record. During testimony questions will not be answered; however, staff will be available to answer questions outside the hearing room. Those interested may contact the Air Quality Division at 517-373-7088 on January 19, 2012, to determine if a hearing was requested and will be held.

After resolving any issues raised during the public comment period and the hearing, a final decision will be made on the permit application.
