

NOTICE of AIR POLLUTION COMMENT PERIOD and PUBLIC HEARING

The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is holding a public comment period from June 15, 2011, until July 19, 2011, and a public hearing also on July 19, 2011, regarding the following three applications:

- Waterfront Petroleum Terminal Company's (Waterfront) proposed installation and operation of two loading racks and three storage tanks. The facility is located at 1071 Miller Road, Dearborn, Michigan. The Permit to Install (PTI) Application Number is 181-10.
- Marathon Petroleum Company LLC's (Marathon) proposed installation and operation of a truck loading rack for asphalt cement. The facility is located at 301 South Fort Street, Detroit, Michigan. The PTI Application Number is 197-10.
- McCoig Materials, LLC's (McCoig) proposed operation of their existing concrete batch plant above the exemption levels in Rule 336.1289. The facility is located at 1441 Springwells Court, Detroit, Michigan. The PTI Application Number is 242-10.

Due to the coincidental timing of the application submittals and the State of Michigan public notice requirements, the Air Quality Division (AQD) has elected to schedule a combined public comment period and hearing for these similarly located projects. The public comment period and hearing are to allow all interested parties the opportunity to comment on the Department's proposed conditional approval of the PTIs. It has been preliminarily determined that each of the proposed actions listed above will not violate any of the Department's rules nor the National Ambient Air Quality Standards.

Additionally, the PTI for the truck loading rack for asphalt cement at the Marathon facility will require revisions to Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) No. 199700013c (SRN A9831). This public comment period meets the public participation requirements for a future administrative amendment to the ROP.

The Question and Answer session will be held from 5:00 p.m. until 6:30 p.m. and the public hearing will be held at 7:00 p.m. During this Question and Answer session, staff will be available to provide information and answer questions about the proposed equipment and draft permits. All statements received by July 19, 2011, will be considered by the decision-maker prior to final permit action.

The sole purpose of the public hearing will be to take formal testimony on the record. During testimony, questions will not be answered; however, staff will be available to answer questions outside the hearing room.
