

NOTICE of AIR POLLUTION COMMENT PERIOD and PUBLIC HEARING

The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) is holding a public comment period from November 2, 2011, until December 7, 2011, and a public hearing also on December 7, 2011, regarding the following applications from Marathon Petroleum Company LP (Marathon).

- Proposed installation and operation of a truck loading rack for asphalt cement. The facility is located at 301 South Fort Street, Detroit, Michigan. The PTI Application Number is 197-10A.
- Proposed minor changes in the scope of the Detroit Heavy Oil Upgrade Project (DHOUP). The facility is located at 1300 South Fort Street, Detroit, Michigan. The PTI Application Number is 63-08C.
- Proposed installation and operation of two storage tanks. The facility is located at 1300 South Fort Street, Detroit, Michigan. The Permit to Install (PTI) Application Number is 96-11.
- Proposed installation and operation of a railcar loading operation for asphalt cement. The facility is located at 1300 South Fort Street, Detroit, Michigan. The PTI Application Number is 142-11.
- Proposed installation and operation of a barge loading operation for asphalt cement. The facility is located at 1300 South Fort Street, Detroit, Michigan. The PTI Application Number is 148-11.

Due to the relatively close timing of the application submittals and the State of Michigan public notice requirements, the Air Quality Division (AQD) has elected to schedule a combined public comment period and hearing for these projects.

The public comment period and hearing are to allow all interested parties the opportunity to comment on the Department's proposed conditional approval of these Permits to Install (PTI). It has been preliminarily determined that the installation of the equipment will not violate any of the Department's rules nor the National Ambient Air Quality Standards.

Additionally, all of this equipment will require revisions to Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) No. 199700013c (SRN A9831). This public comment period meets the public participation requirements for a future administrative amendment to the ROP.

Staff will provide a brief introduction regarding the proposed projects and will be available to answer questions.

All statements received by December 7, 2011, will be considered by the decision-maker prior to final permit actions.

The sole purpose of the public hearing will be to take formal testimony on the record. During testimony, questions will not be answered; however, staff will be available to answer questions outside the hearing room.
