TECHNISAND, INC., LINCOLN & LAKE TWPS., BERRIEN COUNTY, NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE A PERMIT AMENDMENT pursuant to Part 637, Sand Dune Mining, 1994 PA 451, as amended, for the mining of sand within a Designated Sand Dune Area at a site commonly known as the Gulliver-Peters Site (Permit No. TS-GP-100).
