**NOTICE OF AIR POLLUTION CONTROL ADVISORY GROUP PUBLIC MEETING**

The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality is holding a meeting of the Michigan Small Business Clean Air Compliance Advisory Panel (CAP) on **Thursday, December 7, 2006** from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m., in the Katherine Cushman Conference Room, Environmental Science and Services Division, Constitution Hall, 525 W. Allegan Street, Lansing, Michigan. The public is encouraged to attend.

The CAP was created to monitor the effectiveness of the Michigan Clean Air Assistance Program and the Clean Air Ombudsman. The [seven-member panel](#) is comprised of individuals appointed by the Governor, legislators, and the Director of the Department of Environmental Quality to represent citizens, small business owners, and governmental agencies. The CAP is an open forum through which members speak freely and openly about air quality matters. The CAP meets approximately 3-4 times a year. The public comment portion of each meeting provides an opportunity for small business owners, operators and managers to bring issues of concern directly to the attention of CAP members.
