
The Court orders that the motions for immediate consideration are GRANTED.

The motions for leave to file amicus curiae briefs by Mecosta County Development Corporation/Michigan Works! West Central and Michigan Chamber of Commerce are GRANTED by Presiding Judge Meter and Judge Griffin. (Chief Judge Whitbeck not participating.)

The motion for leave to file amicus curiae brief by the Michigan Departments of Environmental Quality, Labor, and Economic Growth is GRANTED.

The Court orders that, in lieu of granting the application for leave to appeal and pursuant to MCR 7.205(D)(2), the motion for a stay of the injunction is GRANTED with the condition that defendant Nestlé Waters' pumping output on a monthly average basis shall not exceed 250 gallons per minute. Nothing in this order shall be construed as precluding the trial court and the parties from conducting the previously scheduled hearing for January 13, 2004, with respect to Nestlé Waters' post-judgment motions.
