Please submit a written response to this Violation Notice by October 6, 2020 (which coincides with 21 calendar days from the date of this letter). The written response should include; an explanation of the causes of the violation; actions taken or planned, in addition to completing land application of the solids, if necessary to correct the cited violations, and the dates by which these actions will take place; and what steps are being taken to prevent a reoccurrence.

Please submit the written response to EGLE, AQD, Bay City District, at 401 Ketchum Street, Suite B, Bay City, Michigan 48708 and submit a copy to Ms. Jenine Camilleri, Enforcement Unit Supervisor at EGLE, AQD, P.O. Box 30260, Lansing, Michigan 48909-7760.

If MSC believes the above observations or statements are inaccurate or do not constitute violations of the applicable legal requirements cited, please provide appropriate factual information to explain your position.
