Detroit Thermal ("DT") submits this response to the February 23, 2016 Violation Notice ("VN") issued by the Air Quality Division ("AQD") of the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality.

The VN alleges that DT violated Permit Condition FG-BOILERS 6,7_SC I.1.1d of DT's Renewable Operating Permit (ROP) and violated Michigan's Air Pollution Control Rules R 336.1213(3)(c), and R336.1213(4)(c).


DT is currently in discussions with the Enforcement Division of the MDEQ regarding these alleged violations and has provided all of the data requested thus far.

DT believes that responding to the VN before the enforcement action is settled would be premature.
