Re: Violation Notice (April 15, 2016)



On March 17, 2016, the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Air Quality Division conducted an inspection of NuPak Solutions, Inc. The inspection resulted in the DEQ issuing a Violation Notice to NuPak Solutions for failure to maintain polystyrene bead processing records and failure to maintain proper records for Rule 290 exemption utilization for their pallet curing oven.

The dates of violation for failure to maintain polystyrene bead processing records were from 1-1-2014 until 4-14-2016. The cause of the violation was because of our belief that when we were no longer required to submit a MAERS report that we no longer had to maintain emission records. Emission records for March 2015 through February 2016 were submitted on 4-14-2016 and we will continue to record emissions every month.

The dates of violation for failure to maintain proper records for Rule 290 exemption utilization were from March 2005 until 4-19-2016. The cause of the violation was ignorance on the part of the NuPak Solutions Operations Manager of the requirement to maintain the records. Records for April 2015 through March 2016 were submitted on 4-19-2016 and we will continue to record VOC emissions every month.
