PTI 193-91 was issued November 15, 1991 for a soil remediation using a vapor vacuum extraction system with carbon adsorption control. The PTI was issued to Pohl Oil Company to clean up BTEX contamination at a bulk fuel storage and dispenser site. A Permit to Operate was requested on April 28, 1995 because the system was installed and startup activities had begun.

Quarterly Air Monitoring Reports were received starting November 15, 1995 until January 21, 1997. A Status Report for January 1997 through August 1997 was received on October 1997 and that is the last report in the AQD file.

I contacted RRD staff, Abby Leinbach about the status of the facility because the PTI was still active. She did not know if the soil remediation system was still on-site. She provided the following information.
